We know it. When it comes to White Privilege, we have to do our own work. But how? Where can we risk being vulnerable with others to really do this work well?

Communities of Practice (COP) for Euro Americans is a program that will help. Using the COP model, we bring together a small group of people who identify as "white" to explore our privilege within the safety and challenge of community.

Each COP is facilitated by a trained leader who will hold the structure in order to allow participants a brave space to do their work. A group covenant will be in place to honor confidentiality and encourage risk-taking through commitments such as truth-telling, mirror-holding, and honest feedback in the framework of compassion and care.

Each group will meet for 90 minutes either monthly or twice a month depending on the plan that is chosen at registration, and group meeting times will be determined by the group.

Each group will commit to one year (meeting once or twice a month each month except July and December) Cost for the once-a-month track will be \$350/year and for the twice-a-month track \$700/year. (Payment plans are available.)
